

Haverfordwest Town Walk



Distance: 2.5 miles

Difficulty: Leisurely

Walking time: 1.5 hours

Accessibility: Not fully suitable for wheelchairs or buggies.

Facilities: There are toilets at the railway station and a small cafe for refreshments. The town centre is also very close. There are also public toilets in the town centre that our walk passes.

Overview: This walk takes you around some of the historic parts of Haverfordwest including the castle, but also guides you through a small nature reserve alongside the Cleddau River.

1. As you leave the train station head **left down the access road**, this joins another road where you need to continue left. At this point you can **follow the blue signs** directing you to the town centre. These will guide you across to the Aldi store and navigate the busy roads **over to Picton Place** which is the bottom of the main street in town.
2. Head up this road as you cross the river and then **head right at Castle Square**. Follow the narrow street on the right of the square passing numerous shops **to eventually arrive at a junction** with a building ahead of you. Go right here where there is a **mini roundabout** and then left to walk to reach a junction by a busy road.
3. Use the pedestrian crossing point on your right to cross safely heading back to your left slightly and then heading right up **Crow Hill Road** passing the nursery. In a short distance take the **signed path down to your right** to enter a wooded area alongside the river. This is **Old Mill Grounds Nature Reserve**. Follow the main path through the reserve to eventually come to a bridge going over the river. Cross this bridge and then head down **the field heading back to town**. Pass through a kissing gate and head right alongside the football field.
4. Continue along this path with the river on your right to eventually **pass a small children's playground** and then use the underpass to head under the main road previously crossed. Take the bridge back over the river and then take the lane **alongside the Ebenezer Church** and then left to pass behind **the Farmers Arms** and then **right to head up Holloway**.
5. As you walk up this road **you'll pass Gloucester Terrace**, and continue around to the left **onto North Street**. Take the next left **into Queens Square** and through onto **Castle Street**. At this point you can take the time to explore the castle and museum.
6. Once you have finished here, return to the entrance gates and **head left down the road**, and then take the steps down on your right to **arrive into a car park**. There are public toilets here. Just next to the toilets take the path up onto the main shopping street, **High Street**. There are food and drink options here.
7. Take the time to explore **High Street**, and once finished head down the road to cross the river again and from there you can retrace your steps across to Aldi and over to the train station.
